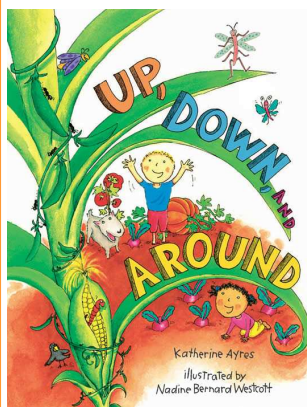


Snapshot Day at WPL
