Globe Trekkers: Teen Class

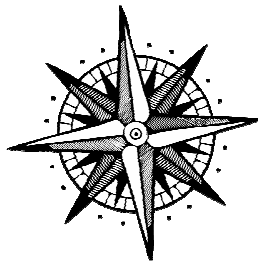
Tuesdays at 5:00 pm
