Registration is required.

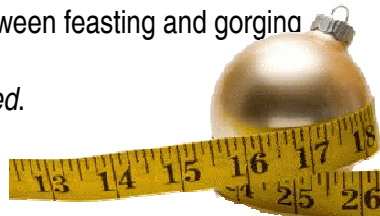
Healthy Holidays
