Join us by the fireplace in the reading room for singing, cookie decorating, and a special surprise from Santa. Opportunity for pictures with Santa will be provided.

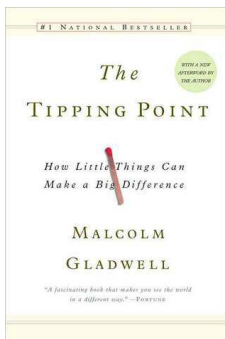
Registration is required by December 12th.

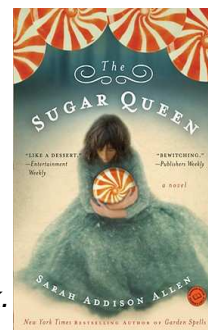
Afternoon Book Club
