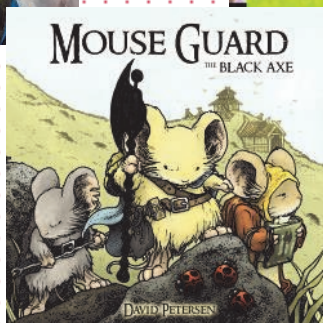
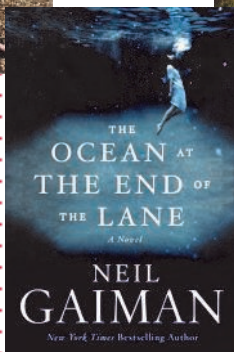
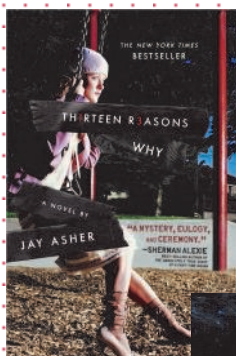

Adult Book Club

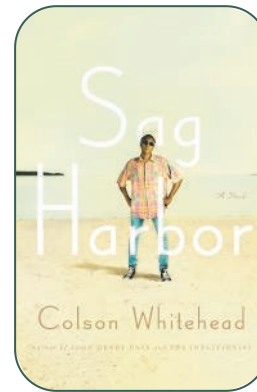
With Guest speaker Dr. John Tidwell @ 6pm
