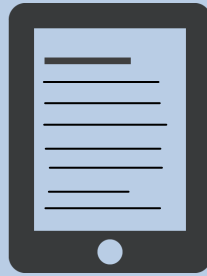

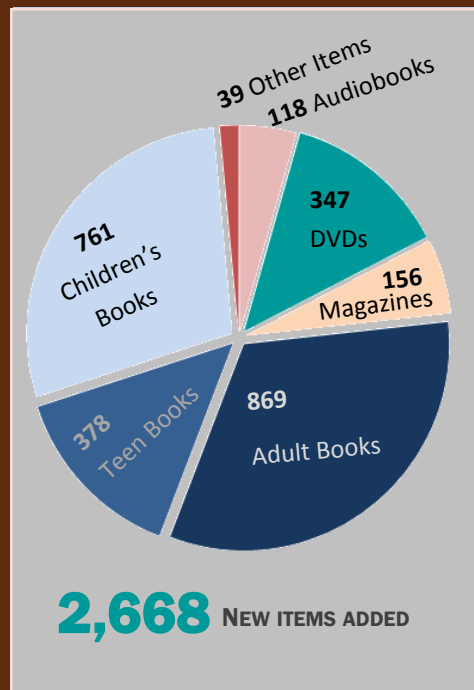

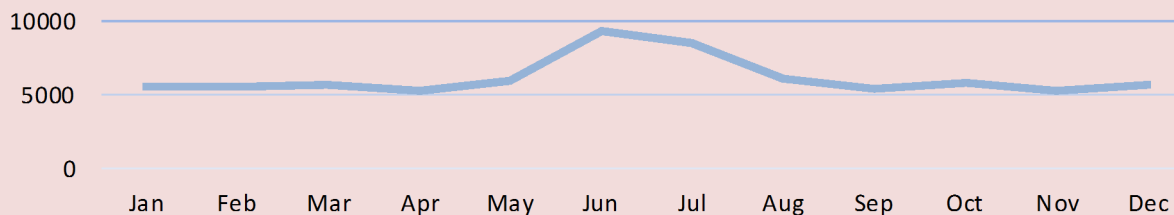

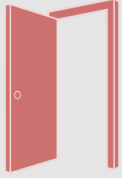


2014 CHECK OUT TIMELINE
